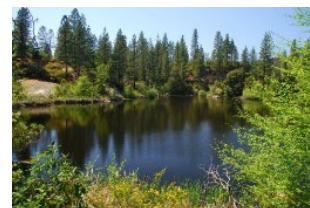

LOCATION

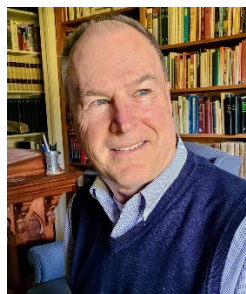
Del Oro Camp and Conference Center, Nevada City, CA

SPEAKER

James Edwards – Author, Professor, and Pastor



James Edwards is a native of Colorado, where his foremost interests as a young man were skiing and mountaineering. He attended Whitworth University, where he led a large Young Life Club. He holds degrees from Whitworth University (1967) and Princeton Theological Seminary, where he earned a Master of Divinity degree (1970). After marrying his wife, Jane, he studied theology at the University of Zürich in Switzerland. He served as Minister of Students at the First Presbyterian Church in Colorado Springs; at the same time, he earned a Ph.D. in New Testament from Fuller Theological Seminary (1978). From 1978 to 1997 Edwards taught religion and chaired the department of Religion and Philosophy at the University of Jamestown (North Dakota), and from 1997 to 2015 he was Professor of Theology at Whitworth University, where he occupied the inaugural Bruner-Welch Chair of Theology.

Edwards has been a short-term translation consultant for Wycliffe Bible Translators in Colombia, and he was a leader-translator for a dozen church visitations to the former East Germany. He also has led numerous study tours to Israel, Turkey, and Greece. He was named to the North Dakota Humanities Council for his studies on the Holocaust. He has received numerous teaching and research awards for teaching excellence. For two decades, Edwards was Contributing Editor at Christianity Today, and he has authored four New Testament commentaries. He has authored more than one hundred journal articles, both scholarly and popular, and ten books, which have been translated into Korean, Spanish, Portuguese, and German. His most recent book, a commentary on Genesis, will be published by Eerdmans Publishing Company in May 2026.

Jim's wife, Jane, is a watercolor artist and leader of women's Bible study groups. Jim and Jane have two grown children and five grandchildren. In 2003 Jim and his son Mark climbed the Mittellegi Ridge of the Eiger in Switzerland.
